

Esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD) Instructions

(Upper Endoscopy)

You have been scheduled for an EGD on _____, to be done by Dr. Hollingsed.

An EGD is a procedure that examines the esophagus, stomach, and first portion of the small intestine (duodenum) using a lighted flexible tube that is inserted into the mouth and advanced to the small intestine. Your procedure has been scheduled to be performed at:

- You will receive IV sedation for this procedure, so please be sure that there is someone with you who can drive you home. You will not be able to leave the facility without this responsible individual.
